<b>Clinical Knowledge</b>	Demonstrates relevant knowledge and understanding of the procedure including indications, contraindications, anatomy, technique, side effects and complications

<b>Consent</b>	Explains procedure to the patient and obtains valid and adequate informed consent

<b>Preparation</b>	Prepares appropriately for the procedure. Ensures assisting staff are present, check equipment and prepares drugs, ensures indicated monitoring, ergonomic arrangement of workspace

<b>Vigilance</b>	Demonstrates situational awareness through constant clinical and electronic monitoring. Maintain focus on the patient, avoids distraction

<b>Infection Control</b>	Demonstrates aseptic/clean technique and standard (universal) precautions

<b>Technical Ability</b>	Demonstrates manual dexterity and confidence; demonstrates adequate interpretation of imaging findings; demonstrates adequate hand eye coordination; demonstrates correct procedural sequence; minimal hesitation and unnecessary actions

<b>Patient Interaction</b>	Provides reassurance, checks for discomfort, concerns and complications

<b>Insight</b>	Knows when to seek assistance, abandon procedure, or arrange alternative care to prevent harm to patient

<b>Radiation Safety Principles</b>	Understands and implements ALARA principle in practice: minimizes use of ionizing radiation and for procedures involving fluoroscopy; satisfactory use of radiation protective equipment
